**REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION**

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. On 9/1/2017 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from Mac's Sewer Service for an SSTS located at 15750-220th ST N which was inspected on 8/29/2017.

Since Mac's Sewer Service has issued a Notice of Non-Compliance for the SSTS, local ordinance requires that the system must be repaired or replaced within six months. Financial assistance is available through Washington County in the form of low-interest loans and grants from low-income residents.
