#### REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. On 10/12/2017 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from All State Septic Services for an SSTS located at 9120 110th ST N which was inspected on 10/2/2017.

Since All State Septic Services has determined the SSTS to be an imminent threat to public health and safety. Local ordinance requires that the system must then be repaired or replaced within 90 days.

Financial assistance is available through Washington County in the form of low-interest loans and grants for low-income residents. The Department recognizes that repairing or replacing an SSTS can seem like a daunting task. Staff are available to answer questions and explain next steps.
