REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County.

The Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from Washington County for an SSTS located at 4305 Dorchester Ct. Woodbury, MN which was inspected on 6/24/2019.

Since receiving t to replace this system the City of Woodbury has informed the Department that municipal sewer may be made available to this neighborhood and they are currently working on evaluating this as part of their work this year and 2020. Please contact the City of Woodbury for more information on the possibility municipal sewer and the evaluation project.

In the interim Washington County will not be requiring replacement of the SSTS serving this property until we know the results of the feasibility study and if municipal sewer service will be made available within a specified timeframe.
