**SUBJECT: Failed Septic System- EXTENSION GRANTED**

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. The Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance (NON) from All State Septic Services for an SSTS located at 9371 Providence Road, Woodbury, MN (Property) which was inspected on 6/17/2020. The Department issued orders on June 19, 2020 requiring the system be repaired or replaced within six months.

Since receiving the NON from All State Septic Services to replace this system, the City of Woodbury has informed the Department that municipal sewer may be made available to this neighborhood. Please contact the City of Woodbury for more information on the possibility of municipal sewer and the evaluation project. In the interim, the Department will not be requiring replacement of the SSTS serving this Property until we know the results of the feasibility study and if municipal sewer service will be made available within a specified timeframe.
