#### SEPTIC SYSTEM PERMIT REMINDER

On December 06, 2021 a permit was issued for a subsurface sewage treatment system (SSTS) located at 7691 Jamaca Ave N to replace the existing non-compliant system. The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment issued orders that the SSTS be replaced within six (6) months.

The six-month deadline has passed, and as of the date of this correspondence, our records show that the new septic system has either not been installed or has not been issued a Certificate of Compliance.
