

If an existing system is not failing as defined in law, and has at least two feet of design soil separation, then the system need not be upgraded, repaired, replaced, or its use discontinued, notwithstanding any local ordinance that is more strict. This provision does not apply to systems in shoreland areas, Wellhead Protection Areas, or those used in connection with food, beverage, and lodging establishments as defined in law.

** This permit shall expire and be null and void if the work authorized by the Suilding Permit is not commenced within 60 days of the date of issuance or if work is abandoned or suspended for a period of 120 days. Term of the Building Permit is 12 months from date of issue. Term of sewage treatment permit is 6 months from date of issue.
