REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

The Washington County Department of Public Health and Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. On 01/18/2022 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from Midwest Sewer Services for an SSTS located at 9928 Stonebridge Trl N, Town Of Stillwater which was inspected on 01/14/2022.

Since Midwest Sewer Services has issued a Notice of Non-Compliance for the SSTS, local ordinance requires that the system must be repaired or replaced within six months. Financial assistance is available through Washington County in the form of low-interest loans and grants for low-income residents. Please visit www.washington.mn.us/septic for more information on financial assistance and the processes of repairing or replacing an SSTS.
