Thank you for your time just now. Per your request, please see attached a copy of the submitted compliance inspection report for the subject property. The system was inspected and found to be noncompliant on 11/9/2022.

<u>Washington County Ordinance</u> requires a compliance inspection prior to the transfer of property according to Section 8.12. These inspections are completed by licensed businesses, certified by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, and submitted to the Public Health & Environment Department. The ordinance does not require the system be upgraded or money posted in escrow prior to property transfer if the system is found to be noncompliant. Existing systems found to be noncompliant shall be replaced or brought into compliance within a timeframe as specified in the ordinance. This information is addressed in a notice of noncompliance issued by the Department.
