## REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. On 8/23/2016 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from All State Septic Services for an SSTS located at 8311 Windbreak Trail N which was inspected on 8/17/2016.

Since All State Septic Services has issued a Notice of Non-Compliance for the SSTS, local ordinance requires that the system must be repaired or replaced within six months. Financial assistance is available through Washington County in the form of low-interest loans and grants from low-income residents.
