You are receiving this letter in response to a recent sub-surface sewage treatment (SSTS) compliance inspection completed on the above property.

The City of Mahtomedi required that septic systems within the city have a compliance inspection completed by the end of 2016. On 9/23/2016 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance for the SSTS serving 1830 MOCCASIN ST.

Due to the findings of this inspection, County ordinance #196 requires that the system must be repaired or replaced within six months. Financial assistance is available through Washington County in the form of low-interest loans and grants from low-income residents. Please visit www.washington.mn.us/septic for more information on financial assistance and the processes of repairing or replacing an SSTS.

The Department recognizes that repairing or replacing an SSTS can seem like a daunting task and we have staff available to answer technical questions about this inspection or the SSTS replacement process.
