On October 5, 2016, the Department ordered that the subsurface sewage treatment system (SSTS) located at 1200 Nightingale Boulevard in the City of Stillwater be repaired or replaced within ninety (90) days.

On December 16, 2016, the Department was provided with an SSTS Abandonment Reporting Form indicating that the tanks were abandoned properly and the home was connected to municipal sewer.
