REGARDING A RECENT SEPTIC SYSTEM COMPLIANCE INSPECTION

The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment (Department) administers Subsurface Sewage Treatment System (SSTS) regulations in Washington County. On 7/14/2017 the Department received a Notice of Non-Compliance from Inspect Minnesota & Midwest Soil Testing for an SSTS located at 9063 Itasca Trail Ct N which was inspected on 7/5/2017.

The Department has reviewed this Notice of Non-Compliance as well as the permit for the SSTS and associated soil borings. The Department finds that the system was designed and installed in conformance with the applicable standards and therefore need *not* be replaced, or its use discontinued, at this time.

The Department also acknowledges the mitigation of the imminent threat to public health referenced in the compliance inspection conducted by Inspect Minnesota & Midwest Soil Testing on 7/5/2017 and referenced in the letter dated 8/10/2017 from the Department, based on an inspection conducted by the Department on 8/29/2017, as a result no further action is required by the Department at this time.
