SEPTIC SYSTEM PERMIT REMINDER

On May 12, 2021 a permit was issued for a subsurface sewage treatment system (SSTS) located at 4290 Northbrook Blvd N to replace the existing non-compliant system. The Washington County Department of Public Health & Environment issued orders that the SSTS be replaced within six (6) months.

The six-month deadline has passed, and as of the date of this correspondence, records show that the new septic system has not been installed or has not been issued a Certificate of Compliance. Please contact Joe Sanders at 651-430-6679 or by email at joe.sanders@co.washington.mn.us and provide an update as to when the SSTS will be replaced and brought into compliance.

The Department recognizes that repairing or replacing an SSTS can seem like a daunting task.
